What was done in 2008

- Collection of physical habitat data, water quality and quantity, and fish production parameters in 16 Canadian sites (8 annual and 8 rotating)
- Juvenile steelhead snorkel surveys
- Trap on Inkaneep Creek (59 steelhead/rainbow trout enumerated)
- Redd survey (6 redds observed)

What will be done in 2009

- Collection of physical habitat data, water quality and quantity, and fish production parameters in 16 Canadian sites (8 annual and 8 rotating)
 - Cross training
 - Data entry
- Juvenile steelhead snorkel surveys
- Trap installation on Inkaneep Creek
 - Scale samples process for aging and stable isotope analysis to determine exposure to marine environments
- No redd surveys
